

PROS AND CONS

At Tough Touring, we have put together our pros and cons for each of the brands of Rooftop tents we stock.

THE PRODUCT: CAMP KING ROOF TOP TENT

WEIGHT: 80kg

COST: Approx \$5280 + Freight (approx \$300)

DIMENSIONS: 1450mm X 2400mm x 300mm

FEATURES: Gas-strut simplicity and Load bearing roof
Superior first class construction and finish.
100% Australian made

AVAILABILITY:

Between 2-6 weeks.

The tents are made in Queensland and are transported regularly to our workshop in Moorabbin.

We try to keep a few ready to go!

PROS

- Excellent reliability and huge internal space
- Space for shoes and bags
- Excellent in wind and rain
- Superior triangulation of awning trusses means no gaping
- Awning largest of all tents in our top 10
- Covers ladder well and stops dew and condensation entering tent
- Midge mesh stops any flying bug in any northern tropical location
(for those of you that believe midge can fly!)
- Huge high angle of lift provides heaps of headroom and sleeping position can be either end
- This is a tall guy's tent, and has massive internal space and no electrickery.
- The best finish quality and the best canvas we've seen
- Excellent ventilation out of enormous side windows
- Great room for two people – enough for shoes at foot of the bed
- Hanging hooks on roof for storage options

CONS

- 45 Degree profile on base makes tent look higher than it is on the roof.
(Minor, but being picky!)
- No awning over side windows
- 1450mm wide is great for space, but can look wide on vehicles with a narrow roof.
